E2a. Long Beach Wastewater System Upgrade - Phase 2 - SP13 CO # 8

Mr. John Wilson explained that Long Beach Wastewater System Upgrade – Phase 2 – SP13 CO # 8 involves a change in extending time to agree with the substantial completion date, from October 28, 2022, to November 23, 2022, allowing for reimbursement funds from MDEQ. Mr. Al Gombos requested clarification if Mayor George Bass was aware and in agreement with the Change Order # 8 extending the substantial completion date to November 23, 2022. Mr. Wilson responded, "Yes."

Mr. Al Gombos made motion to approve Long Beach Wastewater System Upgrade – Phase 2 – SP13 CO # 8, seconded by Supervisor Marlin Ladner with discussion.

Supervisor Marlin Ladner requested clarification on the asphalt specifications and whether the specifications meet MDOT standards and Supervisor Ladner requested clarification if the paving has started and would the paving be monitored, including in the areas of manhole covers. Mr. Wilson explained that the specifications meet MDOT standards, the paving began Tuesday, there is an inspector on site, and if the paving is not up to standards, there will be a request to redo the paving until standards are met.

F. Executive Director's Report

Mr. John Wilson updated the Board on the Long Beach Project. The pumping and flow started thru Price Brothers piping to the plant. There is work required at the plant that will involve new piping to the headworks at the plant and there is required paving. Pipe abandonment will involve

removing pipe from the ground and flushing or grout. Mr. Al Gombos requested clarification, on whether, or not, any of Price Brothers piping exist. Mr. Wilson explained that the Price Brothers pipe that exist, will be abandoned. Supervisor Connie Rockco requested clarification on, whether, or not, the paving companies were required to provide formulars or testing. Mr. Wilson responded, "Yes" and explained that paving mix is submitted and loads are verified.

Mr. Wilson explained to the Board that there are concerns involving the Solid Waste Contract. The Solid Waste Contract requires a unanimous vote. The City of Gulfport has opted out of participation of the Solid Waste Contract. Clarification is needed on whether, or not, The City of Gulfport is required to vote on the Solid Waste Contract. The Solid Waste Contract will be presented at the next Board Meeting, for a vote. Mr. Jim Simpson, Counsel, explained that he has contacted the Attorney General's Office and the matter is being reviewed on whether or not The City of Gulfport is required to vote on the Solid Waste Contract. The statute requires a unanimous vote by all Board Members. Mr. Simpson will update the Board Members, once a response is received from the Attorney General's Office.
